## **Meeting Minutes**

- 1. Equity Action Plan
  - a. How to recruit for DEI and Board Members- remove barriers to participation
  - b. What does DEI committee need from Board members?
    - [ASIDE] Back to School Night- Board table in Great Room
      - 1. Introduce Staff (outside)
      - 2. Parents visit classrooms
- 2. Staff and Student honorary board members
  - a. Get student council going- potential to ask them to select a student who was interested in participating in the board
  - b. Although not voting members, will ask honorary members to participate and bring ideas and will decide things via consensus
  - c. Good opportunity for students to understand how schools/boards are run and how decisions are made
  - d. Staff will help decide how students will be selected
  - e. Consider concept of "executive sessions" for board members only- all board meetings will be public, we can only speak privately about Director's salary
  - f. Because all the topics are public, student and staff honorary members need to be prepared for complicated and sometimes sensitive conversations

- 3. School policy updates- in past board did it on their own, but this year Amanda will work with board to update policies
  - a. Will MOVE on this by November Board Meeting
  - b. Needs to be a collaborative projects
- 4. Director's update
  - a. Enrollment Last year we decided not to fill empty spaces after January
    - i. We are at 204 kids as of today (budgeted for 205, max is 210)
    - ii. Two spots open in 3rd grade and no waitlist for 3rd and 8th grades
    - iii. Considering advertising for certain grades
  - b. Staff- big, exciting staff
    - i. Lots of students who need support
    - ii. We have a lot of support
    - iii. Where we are missing is in SpEd From 2.5 staff down to 1, though more students with IEPs than historic numbers (currently 20% Ss with IEPs)
  - c. When does a school become a Special Education school with specified training for all teachers- conversations with ODE, etc.
  - d. First reported case of Covid for the year came in yesterday (two siblings)
  - e. Arts Park Run is happening this year! We need to recruit parents to help out! Kathy is going to work on recruiting parent volunteers.
- 5. Establishing School calendar for the entire school year- solidifying some dates, keep building out the calendar, can review/approve in October Board Meeting
- 6. Parking still a problem!
